

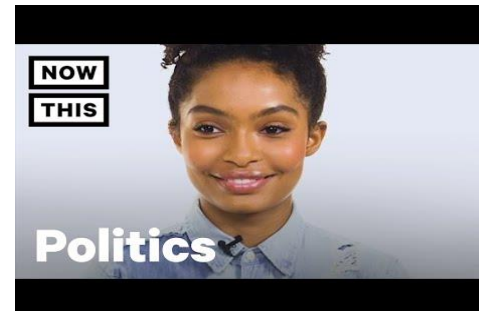


National Social Work Voter Mobilization Campaign

**Election Day is November 6th (and voting has already started)!
There is still time to support your community to vote.**

- **Register voters up until the last day in your state**
 - State-specific deadlines are listed on [this](#) website
 - Students, clients, and/or staff can register to vote online [here](#), if your state allows online registration
 - If someone is not convinced, check out [these](#) reasons to register
- **Inform students, clients, and/or staff about [absentee voting policies](#)**
- **Encourage students, clients, and/or staff to double check their registration status and polling location**
 - Provide [links](#) to look up polling locations
 - Check voter registration status [here](#)
- **Provide [information on voting rights specific to your state](#)**
- **Ask students, clients, and/or staff to **sign a pledge to vote** and post the pledge in a visible location**
 - They can also [sign up](#) for text/email reminders to vote
- **Get the word out that [UBER](#) and [Lyft](#) will be offering free or discounted rides to the polls on Election Day**
